Dear Senator Murante and members of the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee:

The League of Women Voters of Lincoln and Lancaster County is writing to support LB 112, a bill that would allow provisional ballots for voters who move within Nebraska.

A provisional ballot is currently allowed for persons moving with their county of registration. LB 112 will extend this to persons moving with the state.

These provisions would support increased participation in our elections. The improvements that have been made in a reliable state data base of registered voters by the Secretary of State makes current registration information much more accessible than in years past. Voters who move will also appreciate the responsiveness of government to allow them to vote after moving within their state.

The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan organization that encourages informed and active participation in government. The League does not support or oppose candidates. We work to increase understanding of public policy issues and to increase voter participation in elections.
