Chairman Murante and Members of the Government, Military and Veterans
Affairs Committee,

The League of Women Voters of Nebraska opposes LB 912 based on the following
positions of the League of Women Voters of the United States.

Since 2006, with the launch of its Public Advocacy for Voter Protection project, the
League and its constituent state and local members have promoted voter protection as
part of a nationwide effort to prevent the development of processes that threaten to
disenfranchise voters.

Since 2007, the League has opposed state legislation that would require documentary
proof of citizenship or picture ID to register to vote, as well as to vote.

The much repeated argument that requiring photo IDs will prevent voter fraud is a
complete waste of effort to prop up the legislation, as voter fraud has been proven
virtually non-existent in our state.

The League of Women Voters of Nebraska urges you not to advance LB 912 for debate.
